1. If you could provide me with a copy of the audio from the 5/5/08 Council conference session, I'd be most appreciative.
2. Also, found something in the contract that gives the city the right to request the criminal background checks I have requested ... (p. 15 of 18 in the contract). I am therefore reiterating my request for copies of the criminal background checks performed on the Inland employees.

Audit and Inspections

1. During the term of the Agreement and for a period of one (1) year after the termination or expiration of the Agreement for any reason, the City shall have the right to audit, either itself or through an agent, the books and records (including but not limited to technical records) of the Contractor to ensure the Contractor's compliance with all the terms and conditions of the Agreement.
2. During the term of the Agreement, the City shall have the right to inspect any item deemed necessary to ensure that Agreement provisions are/were being met. This can include, but is not limited to: site visits to the office or other locations used under this Agreement, disposal locations, field, shop inspections or equipment, etc.
